

- Thematic approach: the eService is based on 'ecotourism competences'
- Competences include:
 - Asset management (natural and cultural assets in SHAs)
 - Co-governance
 - Partnerships (including stakeholder collaborations)
 - Ecotourism Initiatives (product and service development)
 - Communications
- Those have been used in SHAPE project work packages and activities, such as learning journeys, development of new ecotourism services, and events
- The eService was launched in May 2019 and has been developed step by step to support SHAs and their stakeholders

Development phases

- 1) Review of the needs and inclusion of the stakeholders in the development and use of the eService
- 2) Infrastructure for the e-service:
 - Domain: shapingecotourism.eu
 - Communications (eNewsletter, Social media wall)
 - The joint development forum and the network (WordPress CMS)
- **3) Populating** contents from work packages, inviting users to register in the network (n 50)
- **4) Disseminating and planning for continuation** from sharing of knowledge and information toward joint development
